DIPLOMA EXAM

The oral diploma exam is organised after the fourth semester and completes the two-year course of MA studies. It can be taken during the summer examination session or during the September retake examination session. The exam is based on the topic area of the MA dissertation. Each student needs to answer three questions addressing issues connected with the MA seminar they have attended and with their thesis. The examination board consists of three members of the academic staff: the chairperson, the thesis supervisor and the thesis reviewer. The exam is in English.
